INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 261 - Senator Tavares.

Cosponsors: Senators Lehner, Thomas, Skindell, Yuko, Williams, Schiavoni.

To amend sections 4117.10 and 5747.01 and to enact sections 4143.01, 4143.02, 4143.03, 4143.04, 4143.05, 4143.06, 4143.07, 4143.08, 4143.09, 4143.10, 4143.11, 4143.12, 4143.13, 4143.14, and 4143.99 of the Revised Code to establish family and medical leave insurance benefits to provide paid leave to allow an individual to address the individual's own serious health condition, to care for a family member, or to bond with a new child and to exempt those benefits from personal income tax.

S. B. No. 262 - Senator Tavares.

Cosponsors: Senators Williams, Sykes, Brown.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact section 3313.88 of the Revised Code to require public schools annually to provide parents of students in any of grades five through twelve with educational information regarding eating disorders.

S. B. No. 263 - Senators Huffman, Wilson.

Cosponsors: Senators Terhar, Lehner, Sykes.

To amend sections 109.572, 147.01, 147.03, 147.04, 147.05, 147.06, 147.07, 147.08, 147.13, 147.14, 147.37, 147.371, 147.51, 147.55, and 2303.20, to enact sections 147.011, 147.021, 147.022, 147.031, 147.032,

147.041, 147.051, 147.141, 147.142, 147.542, 147.551, 147.59, 147.591, 147.60, 147.61, 147.62, 147.63, 147.64, 147.65, and 147.66, and to repeal sections 147.02 and 147.09 of the Revised Code to enact the Notary Public Modernization Act.

S. B. No. 264 - Senator Coley.

To require the Auditor of State to conduct and release a performance audit of the Medical Marijuana Control Program, to prohibit the Department of Commerce from issuing final cultivator, processor, or laboratory testing licenses until performance audit recommendations are implemented, and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 265 - Senator Dolan.

To amend sections 173.12, 341.192, 1739.05, 1751.01, 3702.30, 3712.06, 3712.061, and 3963.01 and to enact sections 1751.91, 3923.235, and 3923.89 of the Revised Code to permit certain health insurers to provide payment or reimbursement for services lawfully provided by a pharmacist and to recognize pharmacist services in certain other laws.
