### **INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

**S. B. No. 303** - Senator Brown.

Cosponsors: Senators Williams, O'Brien, Schiavoni, Tavares.

To amend sections 939.03 and 939.07 and to enact sections 901.84 and 901.85 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing agricultural operation and management plans, and to require certain animal feeding facilities to annually report the amount of manure that is applied by or for the facilities.

**S. B. No. 304** - Senators Brown, Yuko.

Cosponsors: Senators Williams, O'Brien, Schiavoni, Tavares.

To amend sections 905.326 and 939.08 and to enact section 939.99 of the Revised Code to generally require the application of fertilizer in the western Lake Erie basin to be applied onto an actively farmed field at the agronomic rate, and to require the application of manure in the western Lake Erie basin to be applied onto an actively farmed field at either the agronomic rate or while utilizing specified best available technologies.
