REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND CONSIDERATION

Senator Obhof reports for the Standing Committee on Rules and Reference, recommending that the following bills, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

S. B. No. 301 - Senator Jordan

To amend sections 4723.01, 4723.06, 4723.24, 4723.43, 4723.432, 4723.44, 4723.482, 4723.50, 4729.01, 4731.27, 4731.35, and 4761.17 and to enact section 4723.484 of the Revised Code regarding the practice of certified registered nurse anesthetists.

To the Committee on Health, Human Services and Medicaid.

S. B. No. 302 - Senator Tavares, et al.

To amend sections 103.13, 106.031, 111.15, and 119.03 and to enact sections 103.132, 103.133, 127.181, and 3701.36 of the Revised Code to create the Health and Equity in All Policies Initiative and the Health and Equity Interagency Team.
