**REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND
CONSIDERATION**

Senator Obhof reports for the Standing Committee on Rules and Reference, recommending that the following bills, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

H. B. No. 123 -Representatives Koehler, Ashford, et al.

To amend sections 1321.35, 1321.36, 1321.39, 1321.40, 1321.41, 1321.422, 1321.99, and 4712.99, to enact new section 1321.46 and sections 1321.141, 1321.401, 1321.402, 1321.403, 1321.411, 1321.595, and 4712.071, and to repeal sections 1321.46 and 1321.461 of the Revised Code to modify the Short-Term Loan Act, to specify a minimum duration requirement for loans made under the Small Loan Law and Mortgage Loan Law, and to limit the authority of credit services organizations to broker extensions of credit for buyers.

To the Committee on Finance.

H. B. No. 411 -Representatives Seitz, Sykes, et al.

To amend sections 2305.02 and 2743.48 of the Revised Code to modify the state's wrongful imprisonment law.

To the Committee on Judiciary.

H. B. No. 433 -Representatives Kelly, Brinkman, et al.

To amend section 4741.16 of the Revised Code to allow a licensed veterinarian to receive up to two continuing education credits per biennium for performing free spaying and neutering services.

To the Committee on Agriculture.

H. B. No. 535 -Representative Gavarone, et al.

To amend sections 4729.01, 4729.44, 4729.75, 4729.79, and 4729.85 and to enact sections 3727.25 and 4765.45 of the Revised Code to require certain reports regarding overdoses and naloxone, to include naltrexone within the

Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System, and to name this act the "Opioid Data and Communication Expansion Act."

To the Committee on Health, Human Services and Medicaid.

S. B. No. 308 -Senators Uecker, Yuko

To amend sections 121.084, 4105.01, 4105.10, and 4105.15 and to enact sections 4105.101, 4105.30, 4785.01, 4785.02, 4785.03, 4785.04, 4785.041, 4785.05, 4785.051, 4785.06, 4785.07, 4785.08, 4785.09, 4785.091, 4785.092, and 4785.99 of the Revised Code to revise the Elevator Law.

To the Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Workforce.

S. B. No. 309 -Senators Peterson, Kunze, et al.

To amend sections 122.17, 3735.65, 3735.67, 3735.671, 5709.61, 5709.62, 5709.63, 5709.631, 5709.632, and 5751.01 and to enact sections 5751.052 and 5751.091 of the Revised Code to lengthen the maximum term of the job creation tax credit for businesses making substantial fixed asset and employment investments and for their suppliers, to authorize commercial activity tax exclusions for receipts of those suppliers from sales to such businesses, and to authorize local governments to grant longer term property tax exemptions for such businesses or suppliers.
