A C O N C U R R E N T R E S O L U T I O N

To approve Ohio's state education plan for implementation 1
of the federal Every Student Succeeds Act. 2

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 3
1965, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015, Pub. 4
L. No. 114-95, requires each state educational agency to submit 5
a state plan or consolidated state plan in order to receive 6
federal funds; and 7

WHEREAS, In accordance with guidance issued by the United 8
States Department of Education, each state educational agency is 9
required to prepare a state plan or consolidated state plan and 10
submit that plan to the Department by either April 3, 2017, or 11
September 18, 2017; and 12

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Education has submitted its 13
state plan to the United States Department of Education; and 14

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Education, in accordance 15
with division (B)(1) of section 3302.09 of the Revised Code as 16
amended by the 132nd General Assembly, has submitted a written 17
copy of its state plan to each of the members of the standing 18
committees on primary and secondary education of the Senate and 19

the House of Representatives; and 20

WHEREAS, Division (C) of section 3302.09 of the Revised 21
Code requires that Ohio's state plan must be approved by a 22
concurrent resolution of the General Assembly prior to 23
implementation; now therefore be it 24

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 132nd General 25
Assembly of the State of Ohio, in adopting this concurrent 26
resolution approve the Ohio Department of Education's state 27
plan; and be it further 28

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives 29
shall transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to 30
the State Board of Education, the Superintendent of Public 31
Instruction, and the news media of Ohio. 32
