Section 7 of Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Ohio	11

Section 7. (A)(1) Not later than the 2019-2020 school	14
year, the General Assembly shall provide for the establishment	15
of a free public preschool education program that is open to all	16
children of preschool age in the State of Ohio. The program	17
shall be an organized program that addresses and enhances each	18

child's ability to make age appropriate progress in an age	19

(2) The program shall be made available to any child who	21
is four or five years of age, who resides in the state, and who	22
has not yet enrolled in a kindergarten education program.	23
