A RESOLUTION

Honoring Officer Alan Horujko for his outstanding heroism.

WHEREAS, A member of The Ohio State University Police Division since 2015, Alan Horujko is truly deserving of widespread commendation, for he has demonstrated an exceptional presence of mind and a degree of bravery of which he can be justly proud. On November 28, 2016, he acted swiftly to end an attack on campus, jeopardizing his own safety to protect students and staff. Reacting quickly and capably to this crisis situation, he responded within seconds and was able to prevent further injuries; and
