In memory of Officer Eric Joering.

WHEREAS, Eric Joering left an indelible impression on the people whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. A seventeen-year veteran of the Westerville Division of Police, where he served as a detective with his K-9 partner, Sam, he was the recipient of numerous accolades, including the Exceptional Duty Award, and he was killed in the line of duty on February 10, 2018. His contributions to his profession were, indeed, noteworthy; and

WHEREAS, Giving generously of his energy and abilities, Eric Joering displayed exceptional concern and insight, and he was tireless in his efforts to better the world around him.
