A RESOLUTION

Honoring the City of Worthington on its Two Hundred
Fifteenth Anniversary

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 132nd General 1

Worthington on the auspicious occasion of its Two Hundred 3

WHEREAS, Platted by James Kilbourne, the City of Worthington 5
was settled in 1803 by eleven families from Connecticut, and it 6
was named in honor of Thomas Worthington, who helped locate and 7
purchase the land and who was one of Ohio's first senators. 8
Recognition of this prestigious milestone is, indeed, a fitting 9
tribute to the city, for over the past two hundred fifteen years, 10
it has become known for its residents' cooperation, integrity, and 11
willingness to work hard, exemplary qualities that are still 12
