**A RESOLUTION**

Honoring Bo Jordan on winning a 2017 Big Ten Conference  
Wrestling Championship.

Big Ten Conference Wrestling Champion in the 174-pound weight 3

WHEREAS, Displaying exceptional form, ability, leadership, 5  
and dedication during the 2016-2017 season, Bo Jordan has 6  
certainly distinguished himself as one of the most talented 7  
wrestlers in the State of Ohio. A junior at The Ohio State 8  
University, he defeated a tough opponent from Penn State 9  
University by the score of 6-4 to secure the Big Ten Conference 10  
Championship in the 174-pound weight class, and he followed that 11  
by finishing as the runner-up in that division at the National 12  
Collegiate Athletic Association Tournament; and 13

WHEREAS, Throughout intense training and preparation, Bo 14  
Jordan has consistently demonstrated the talent, integrity, and 15  
motivation that are the hallmarks of a true champion. He has 16
