A BILL

To amend section 4303.051 of the Revised Code to 1 revise the law governing alcoholic ice cream. 2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4303.051 of the Revised Code be	3
amended to read as follows:	4
Sec. 4303.051. (A) Permit A-5 may be issued to a	5
manufacturer of ice cream to manufacture ice cream that contains	6
not less than one-half of one per cent of alcohol by volume and	7
not more than six per cent of alcohol by volume, provided that	8
the sale of beer or intoxicating liquor for on- and off-premises-	9
consumption is authorized in the election precinct in which the	10
manufacturer is located and to sell that ice cream to either of	11
the following:	12
(1) A personal consumer for consumption on the premises	13
where manufactured or in sealed containers for consumption off	14
the premises where manufactured;	15
(2) A retail permit holder that is authorized to sell beer	16

or intoxicating liquor.	17
(B)—An A-5 permit holder may sell ice cream under this—	18
section only for consumption on the premises where manufactured-	19
or in sealed containers for consumption off the premises where-	20
manufactured. An A-5 permit holder may sell ice cream under this-	21
section only by in-person transaction at the permit premises. An-	22
A-5 permit holder shall not ship, send, or use an H permit	23
holder to deliver ice cream to a personal consumer. An A-5	24
permit holder shall not sell more than four pints of ice cream-	25
for off-premises consumption to a personal consumer in any	26
calendar day No A-5 permit shall be issued unless the sale of	27
beer or intoxicating liquor for on- and off-premises consumption	28
is authorized in the election precinct in which the manufacturer	29
applying for the permit is located.	30
(C) An A-5 permit holder may ship ice cream the permit	31
holder has manufactured under this section to a personal	32
consumer via the holder of an H permit, subject to all of the	33
<pre>following:</pre>	34
(1) The package in which the ice cream is being shipped is	35
clearly marked with the words "alcohol enclosed" in bold print.	36
(2) Prior to sending a shipment of ice cream, the A-5	37
permit holder, or an employee of the permit holder, makes a bona	38
fide effort to ensure that the personal consumer is at least	39
twenty-one years of age.	40
(3) Upon delivering a shipment of ice cream, the H permit	41
holder, or an employee of the permit holder, verifies that the	42
personal consumer is at least twenty-one years of age by	43
checking the personal consumer's driver's license, commercial	44
driver's license, identification card issued under sections	45

(D) An A-5 permit holder shall keep a record of each	49
shipment of ice cream that the permit holder sends to a personal	50
consumer under division (C) of this section. The A-5 permit	51
holder shall annually provide to the division of liquor control	52
by electronic means a report that includes all of the following:	53
(1) The name and address of each personal consumer that	54
purchased ice cream from the A-5 permit holder via shipment	55
under this section;	56
(2) The quantity of ice cream purchased by each personal	57
<pre>consumer;</pre>	58
(3) Any other information requested by the division.	59
The division shall prescribe and provide an electronic	60
form for the report and shall determine the specific electronic	61
means that the A-5 permit holder must use to submit the report.	62
(C) (E) A retail permit holder that is authorized to sell	63
beer or intoxicating liquor may sell ice cream that contains not	64
less than one-half of one per cent of alcohol by volume and not	65
more than six per cent of alcohol by volume and that is	66
manufactured by an A-5 permit holder or by an equivalent	67
manufacturer in another state. Such a manufacturer in another	68
state may sell such ice cream to a retail permit holder in this	69
state.	70
(F) The fee for an A-5 permit is one thousand dollars for	71
each plant.	72
