BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5301.073 and 5311.192 of the						
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:						
Sec. 5301.073. (A) As used in this section, "solar_	9					
collector system" means a solar collector or other solar energy	10					
device, the primary purpose of which is to provide for the	11					
collection, storage, and distribution of solar energy for	12					
electricity generation, space heating, space cooling, or water						
heating.	14					
(B) No covenant, condition, or restriction set forth in a	15					
deed, and no rule, regulation, bylaw, or other governing	16					
document or agreement of a homeowners, neighborhood, civic, or_						

other association, shall impose or be construed to impose any					
unreasonable limitation on the installation of a solar collector					
system on the roof or exterior walls of improvements, provided					
the property owner owns or has the right to exclusive use of the					
roof or exterior walls. For purposes of this division,					
"unreasonable limitation" includes a limitation that					
significantly increases the cost, or significantly decreases the					
efficiency, of the solar collector system.	25				
(C) If a property owner installs or intends to install a	26				
solar collector system, the property owner may negotiate to	27				
obtain a solar access easement described in section 5301.63 of	28

Sec. 5311.192. (A) As used in this section, "solar	30

(B) No declaration, bylaw, rule, regulation, or agreement	36
