A BILL

To amend section 2915.101 of the Revised Code to	1
reduce the amount a veteran's, fraternal, or	2
sporting organization conducting instant bingo	3
is required to donate to a public charity or	4
governmental unit.	5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2915.101 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7
Sec. 2915.101. Except as otherwise provided by law, a	8
charitable organization that conducts instant bingo shall	9
distribute the net profit from the proceeds of the sale of	10
instant bingo as follows:	11
(A)(1) If a veteran's organization, a fraternal	12
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organization, or a sporting organization conducted the instant	13
bingo, the organization shall distribute the net profit from the	14
proceeds of the sale of instant bingo, as follows:	15
(a) For the first one hundred thousand dollars, the	16
organization is not required to make a distribution.	17

(b) For the first more than one hundred thousand dollars	18
to not more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars, or a	19
greater amount prescribed by the attorney general to adjust for	20
changes in prices as measured by the consumer price index as	21
defined in section 325.18 of the Revised Code and other factors	22
affecting the organization's expenses, as defined in division	23
(GG) of section 2915.01 of the Revised Code, or less of net	24
profit from the proceeds of the sale of instant bingo generated	25
in a calendar year:	26
(i) At least twenty-five <u>ten</u>per cent shall be distributed	27
to an organization described in division (V)(1) of section	28
2915.01 of the Revised Code or to a department or agency of the	29
federal government, the state, or any political subdivision.	30
(ii) Not more than seventy-five <u>ninety</u> per cent may be	31
deducted and retained by the organization for reimbursement of	32
or for the organization's expenses, as defined in division (GG)	33
of section 2915.01 of the Revised Code, in conducting the	34
instant bingo game.	35
$\frac{(b)}{(c)}$ For any net profit from the proceeds of the sale	36
of instant bingo of more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars	37
or an adjusted amount generated in a calendar year:	38
(i) A minimum of fifty per cent shall be distributed to an	39
organization described in division (V)(1) of section 2915.01 of	40
the Revised Code or to a department or agency of the federal	41
government, the state, or any political subdivision.	42
(ii) Five per cent may be distributed for the	43
organization's own charitable purposes or to a community action	44
agency.	45
(iii) Forty-five per cent may be deducted and retained by	46

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the organization for reimbursement of or for the organization's47expenses, as defined in division (GG) of section 2915.01 of the48Revised Code, in conducting the instant bingo game.49

(2) If a veteran's organization, a fraternal organization, 51 or a sporting organization does not distribute the full 52 percentages specified in divisions (A) (1) $\frac{(a)}{(b)}$ (b) and $\frac{(b)}{(c)}$ (c) of 53 this section for the purposes specified in those divisions, the 54 organization shall distribute the balance of the net profit from 55 the proceeds of the sale of instant bingo not distributed or 56 retained for those purposes to an organization described in 57 division (V)(1) of section 2915.01 of the Revised Code. 58

(B) If a charitable organization other than a veteran's organization, a fraternal organization, or a sporting organization conducted the instant bingo, the organization shall distribute one hundred per cent of the net profit from the proceeds of the sale of instant bingo to an organization described in division (V) (1) of section 2915.01 of the Revised Code or to a department or agency of the federal government, the state, or any political subdivision.

(C) Nothing in this section prohibits a veteran's 67 organization, a fraternal organization, or a sporting 68 organization from distributing any net profit from the proceeds 69 of the sale of instant bingo to an organization that is 70 described in subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code 71 when the organization that is described in subsection 501(c)(3) 72 of the Internal Revenue Code is one that makes donations to 73 other organizations and permits donors to advise or direct such 74 donations so long as the donations comply with requirements 75 established in or pursuant to subsection 501(c)(3) of the 76

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Internal Revenue Code.	77
Section 2. That existing section 2915.101 of the Revised	78
Code is hereby repealed.	79
