A BILL

To make an appropriation to continue to fund the 1
Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, 2
Temporary Assistance for Needy Families 3
programs, and Special Supplemental Nutrition 4
Program for Women, Infants, and Children 5
contingent upon a lapse in federal funding. 6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) As used in this section: 7

(1) "SNAP" means the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance 8
Program administered by the Department of Job and Family 9
Services pursuant to section 5101.54 of the Revised Code. 10

(2) "TANF programs" means the Temporary Assistance for 11
Needy Families programs identified in division (A)(4) of section 12
5101.80 of the Revised Code. 13

(3) "WIC" means the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program 14
for Women, Infants, and Children established under Section 17 of 15
the "Child Nutrition Act of 1966," 42 U.S.C. 1786. 16

(B) Contingent upon a lapse in federal funding, the 17
Director of Job and Family Services shall certify to the 18
Director of Budget and Management the amount necessary to 19
continue to fund the SNAP and TANF programs and the Director of 20
Health shall certify the amount necessary to continue to fund 21
the WIC program. The amount shall be equivalent to the amount 22
that otherwise would have been received for the respective 23
programs. 24

(C) Subject to division (B) of this section, there is 25
hereby appropriated from the Budget Stabilization Fund the 26
amount necessary, up to the balance in the Budget Stabilization 27
Fund, to continue to fund the SNAP, TANF, and WIC programs. 28
Authorization of this funding expires when the federal 29
government resumes funding operations. 30

Within the limits set forth in this act, the Director of 31
Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the 32
source and amount of funds for the appropriations made in this 33
act, and shall determine the form and manner in which 34
appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from 35
the appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for 36
as though made in the main operating appropriations act of the 37
133rd General Assembly. 38

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 39
provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 133rd 40
General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 41
appropriations. 42

(D) The Director of Job and Family Services shall certify 43
to the Director of Budget and Management the amount received in 44
federal reimbursement for the SNAP and TANF programs after the 45
lapse in federal funding has ended and the Director of Health 46

shall certify the amount received in federal reimbursement for 47
the WIC program after the lapse in federal funding has ended. 48
The Director of Budget and Management shall transfer the 49
certified amount from the appropriate fund to the Budget 50
Stabilization Fund. 51

Section 2. Section 1 of this act is exempt from the 52
referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, Section 1d and 53
section 1.471 of the Revised Code and takes effect immediately 54
when this act becomes law. 55
