**A BILL**

To exempt school districts and educational service  
centers from prohibitions against reductions in  
student transportation for the 2020-2021 school  
year and to declare an emergency. 1

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** Notwithstanding section 3327.015 of the Revised  
Code, the prohibition against reductions in student  
transportation after the beginning of the school year prescribed  
by that section shall not apply to any city, local, or exempted  
village school districts or educational service centers for the  
2020-2021 school year. That section shall again apply to school  
districts and service centers beginning in the 2021-2022 school  
year. 5

**Section 2.** This act is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to  
allow school districts and educational service centers to make  
adjustments to their student transportation schedules in a  
timely manner. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate  
effect. 13
