**A BILL**

To enact section 5534.419 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate a portion of State Route 184 in Lucas 2  
County as the "Officer Anthony Dia Memorial 3  
Highway." 4

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5534.419 of the Revised Code be 5  
enacted to read as follows: 6

**Sec. 5534.419.** In addition to any other name prescribed by 7  
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 8  
of state route number one hundred eighty-four, between mile 9  
marker six and mile marker seven, in Lucas county, shall be 10  
known as the "Officer Anthony Dia Memorial Highway." 11

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 12  
along the highway indicating its name. 13
