BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3303.08 of the Revised Code be	3
enacted to read as follows:	4
Sec. 3303.08. (A) As used in this section:	5
(1) "Apprentice" and "council office" have the same	6
meanings as in section 4139.01 of the Revised Code.	7
(2) "Pre-apprentice" has the same meaning as in section	8
4123.038 of the Revised Code.	9
(B) The department of education, in conjunction with the	10
department of higher education, the council office, and the	11
state board established under section 6301.04 of the Revised	12
Code for workforce development, shall develop and administer the	13
career pathways apprentice program for students in grades nine	14
through twelve.	15
(C) The program shall do the following:	16

(1) Establish partnerships between schools, businesses,	17				
communities, local government entities, and nonprofit	18				
organizations to create career pathways for apprenticeships in	19				
the following professions:					
(a) Manufacturing;	21				
(b) Information technology;	22				
(c) Financial services;	23

(2) Provide information and technical assistance to high	27				
school students who enroll in the program;	28
