BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3749.01 of the Revised Code be	7

Sec. 3749.01. As used in sections 3749.01 to 3749.10 of	9

(A) "Board of health" means a city board of health or a	11	
general health district, or an authority having the duties of a		
city board of health as authorized by section 3709.05 of the		
Revised Code.		
(B) "Health district" means any city or general health	15	
district created pursuant to section 3709.01 of the Revised	16	

Code. (C) "Person" means the state, any political subdivision, 18 special district, public or private corporation, individual, 19 firm, partnership, association, or any other entity. (D) "Licensor" means a city board of health or a general 21 health district, an authority having the duties of a city board of health as authorized pursuant to section 3709.05 of the Revised Code, or the director of the department of health when acting under section 3749.07 of the Revised Code. (E) "Director" means the director of the department of 26 health or his an authorized representative of the director of health. (F) "Private residential swimming pool" means any indoor 29 or outdoor structure, chamber, or tank containing a body of water for swimming, diving, or bathing located at a dwelling housing no more than three families and used exclusively by theany of the following: (1) The dwelling's residents and their; (2) The resident's nonpaying guests; (3) A paying guest of a resident if the guest is participating in a certified swimming class conducted by the resident, provided that both of the following apply: (a) The resident is a certified swimming instructor and is conducting the certified swimming class on a one-on-one basis; (b) Not more than four individuals are in the pool at the

(G) "Public swimming pool" means any indoor or outdoor

structure, chamber, or tank containing a body of water for44swimming, diving, or bathing that is intended to be used45collectively for swimming, diving, or bathing and is operated by46any person whether as the owner, lessee, operator, licensee, or47concessionaire, regardless of whether or not <u>a</u> fee is charged48for use, but does not mean any public bathing area or private49residential swimming pool.50

(H) "Public spa" means any public swimming pool that is typically operated as a smaller, higher temperature pool for recreational or nonmedical uses.

(I) "Special use pool" means a public swimming pool containing flume slides, wave generating equipment, or other special features that necessitate different design and safety requirements. "Special use pool" does not include any water slide or wave generating pool at a public amusement area which is licensed and inspected by the department of agriculture pursuant to sections 1711.50 to 1711.57 of the Revised Code.

(J) "Public bathing area" means an impounding reservoir, basin, lake, pond, creek, river, or other similar natural body of water.

(K) "Certified swimming class" means an infant swimming64resource (ISR) class; an American red cross swimming class,65swimming lesson, or learn-to-swim class; and any other swimming66class certified by a nationally accredited organization that67operates in all fifty states.68

(L) "Certified swimming instructor" means a certified ISR69instructor; a certified American red cross swimming instructor70or swim coach; and any other swim instructor certified by a71nationally accredited organization that operates in all fifty72

73 states. Section 2. That existing section 3749.01 of the Revised 74 Code is hereby repealed. 75 76 Section 3. It is not the intent of the General Assembly that any provision in this act be interpreted as either limiting 77 or restricting an insurer's ability to do any of the following: 78 (A) Exclude insurance coverage from any insurance policy; 79 (B) Underwrite any insurance policy; or 80 (C) Create, imply, or otherwise grant insurance coverage 81 not found in a policy of insurance. 82 Section 4. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency 83 measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 84 peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to 85 continue the essential operation of certified swimming classes. 86 Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect. 87
