**Sub. S. B. No. 47 – Senator Eklund**

**Cosponsors: Senators Thomas, Manning, Coley, Gavarone**

To amend sections 2929.17, 2953.32, and 2953.36 and to enact section 2950.151 of the Revised Code to create a procedure for certain offenders convicted of unlawful sexual conduct with a minor to petition a court for reclassification or removal from duties under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Law and to permit record sealing in those cases.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill April 10, 2019)

**Am. S. B. No. 49 – Senator Eklund**

To amend section 2933.32 of the Revised Code to authorize a corrections officer to cause a body cavity search to be conducted or to conduct a strip search and to establish separate rules for conducting strip searches.

(Committee on Government Oversight and Reform recommends passage)

**Am. S. B. No. 98 – Senator Maharath**

To amend section 121.30 and to enact sections 121.34 and 121.341 of the Revised Code to create the Ohio Asian-American and Pacific Islander Affairs Commission and the Office of Asian-American and Pacific Islander Affairs.

(Committee on Finance recommends passage)

**S. B. No. 112 – Senator Eklund**

**Cosponsor: Senator Terhar**

To amend sections 9.45, 2925.01, 4710.01, 4710.03, 4710.04, 4712.01, and 4712.99; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicated in parentheses, sections 4710.01 (4712.50), 4710.02 (4712.51), 4710.03 (4712.52), and 4710.04 (4712.53); to enact section 4712.54; and to repeal section 4710.99 of the Revised Code regarding debt adjusting.

(Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions recommends passage September 2, 2020)

**Am. S. B. No. 148 – Senator Schuring**

To amend sections 1751.85, 1753.09, 3901.21, 3923.86, 3963.01, 3963.02, 3963.03, and 4715.30 of the Revised Code regarding limitations imposed by health insurers on dental care services.

(Committee on Insurance and Financial Institutions recommends passage)  
(For amendments see Senate Journal February 5, 2020)

**Sub. S. B. No. 312 – Senator McColley**

**Cosponsor: Senator Coley**

To amend sections 1901.123, 1907.143, 2151.07, 2301.02, and 2301.03 and to enact section 2101.027 of the Revised Code to reallocate jurisdictional responsibilities of current judges of the Hardin County Court of Common Pleas, to create the Domestic Relations Division of the Hardin County Court of Common Pleas, and to modify the provisions regarding the reimbursement of assigned municipal and county court judges.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill September 23, 2020)

**Sub. S. B. No. 313 – Senator Johnson**

To amend Section 265.210 of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly, as subsequently amended, to require the Department of Education to make an additional payment in fiscal year 2020 or 2021 to certain city, local, exempted village, and joint vocational school districts that experience a decrease in the taxable value of the district's utility tangible personal property and have at least one power plant in their territories.

(Committee on Finance recommends passage of substitute bill June 10, 2020)

**S. B. No. 316 – Senator Dolan**

**Cosponsors: Senators Hottinger, Schuring, Kunze**

To amend Section 812.10 of H.B. 529 of the 132nd General Assembly, to make capital reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2022, and to declare an emergency.

(Committee on Finance recommends passage June 3, 2020)

**S. B. No. 317 – Senator Coley**

To amend section 109.78 of the Revised Code to expressly exempt, from a requirement that peace officer basic training be obtained, certain employees that a board of education or governing body of a school authorizes to go armed in a school safety zone within which the board or governing body has authority.

(Committee on Government Oversight and Reform recommends passage September 2, 2020)

**S. J. R. No. 3 – Senator Burke**

**Cosponsors: Senators Roegner, Rulli, Schaffer, McColley, Wilson, Huffman, S., Huffman, M., Hackett, Eklund, Gavarone, Obhof**

Proposing to enact Section 7 of Article XII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to require that any increase in income tax rates be approved by a supermajority of the membership of each house of the General Assembly.

(Committee on Ways and Means recommends adoption June 9, 2020)

**Am. S. C. R. No. 9 – Senator Craig**

**Cosponsors: Senators Roegner, Kunze, Hackett**

Eliminates provisions designating November 14th as Cardiac Amyloidosis Recognition Day and instead designates March as Cardiac Amyloidosis Recognition Month.

(Committee on Health, Human Services and Medicaid recommends adoption)

**Sub. H. B. No. 136 – Representative Hillyer**

To amend sections 2929.02, 2929.022, 2929.024, 2929.03, 2929.04, 2929.06, 2929.14, 2941.148, 2953.21, 2953.23, 2971.03, 2971.07, and 5120.61 and to enact section 2929.025 of the Revised Code to prohibit imposing the death penalty for aggravated murder when the offender had a serious mental illness at the time of the offense.

To amend sections 2903.11, 2903.12, 2903.13, and 2935.01 of the Revised Code to increase penalties for certain assault offenses if the victim is a hospital police officer or special police officer and to include gaming agents of the Casino Control Commission as peace officers under the general statutory definition of that term.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill February 6, 2020)

**Sub. H. B. No. 295 – Representative Hoops**

To amend sections 4501.01, 4509.01, 4511.01, 4511.513, 4511.522, 4511.68, and 4511.711 and to enact section 4511.514 of the Revised Code to establish requirements governing low-speed micromobility devices and to make other changes to the law related to special modes of transportation.

(Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Workforce recommends passage of substitute bill February 12, 2020)
