**Bills for Third Consideration**

**Sub. S. B. No. 2 – Senators Peterson, Dolan**

**Cosponsors: Senators Maharath, O'Brien, Schaffer**

To amend sections 939.02, 940.06, 6119.06, 6119.09, and 6119.091 and to enact sections 940.36 and 940.37 of the Revised Code to create the Statewide Watershed Planning and Management Program under the administration of the Director of Agriculture and to make changes to the law governing regional water and sewer districts.

(Committee Agriculture and Natural Resources recommends passage of substitute bill June 12, 2019)

**S. B. No. 95 – Senators Peterson, Kunze**

**Cosponsors: Senators Wilson, Rulli, Hackett, Huffman, S., Lehner, Terhar, Schaffer, Manning, Schuring**

To amend sections 122.17, 3735.65, 3735.67, 3735.671, 5709.61, 5709.62, 5709.63, 5709.631, 5709.632, and 5751.01 of the Revised Code to enhance state and local tax inducements for businesses making substantial fixed asset and employment investments and their suppliers.

(Committee on Ways and Means recommends passage May 23, 2019)

To amend sections 107.036, 5725.98, and 5729.98 and to enact sections 122.09, 5725.35, and 5729.18 of the Revised Code to authorize an insurance premiums tax credit for capital contributions to transformational mixed use development projects.

(Committee on Finance recommends passage of substitute bill June 6, 2019)

**Sub. S. B. No. 47 – Senator Eklund**

**Cosponsors: Senators Thomas, Manning, Coley, Gavarone**

To amend sections 2929.17, 2953.32, and 2953.36 and to enact section 2950.151 of the Revised Code to create a procedure for certain offenders convicted of unlawful sexual conduct with a minor to petition a court for reclassification or removal from duties under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Law and to permit record sealing in those cases.

(Committee on Judiciary recommends passage of substitute bill April 10, 2019)

**Am. S. B. No. 49 – Senator Eklund**

To amend section 2933.32 of the Revised Code to authorize a corrections officer to cause a body cavity search to be conducted or to conduct a strip search and to establish separate rules for conducting strip searches.
