INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 151 - Representative Carfagna.

Cosponsors: Representatives Carruthers, Edwards, Ginter, Hood, LaTourette, Lipps, Manning, D., O'Brien, Plummer, Roemer, Schaffer, West.

To amend sections 4734.04, 4734.05, 4734.25, and 4734.283 and to enact sections 3702.98, 3702.981, 3702.982, 3702.983, 3702.984, 3702.985, 3702.986, 3702.987, 3702.988, 3702.989, 3702.9810, and 4734.251 of the Revised Code to create the Chiropractic Loan Repayment Program and to revise certain laws administered by the State Chiropractic Board.

H. B. No. 152 - Representative Brinkman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Lang, Merrin, Riedel.

To amend sections 511.27, 511.28, 1545.041, 1545.21, 5705.23, 5705.34, and 5739.023 and to enact sections 511.271, 1545.212, and 5705.17 of the Revised Code to require certain subdivisions to obtain the approval of the body that created the subdivision before levying a tax.

H. B. No. 153 - Representative Becker.

To amend section 305.03 of the Revised Code to modify the law regarding declaring a county office vacant for failure to perform duties, including failure to appear at the officer's principle office location, and to designate this act the "Working Officials Requirements Key Act" or "WORK Act."

H. B. No. 154 - Representatives Miller, J., Jones.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lepore-Hagan, Oelslager, Brent, Hambley, Kent, Manning, D., Miranda, Kelly, Crossman, Lightbody, Edwards, Sobecki, Russo, Sheehy, Ingram, Weinstein, Holmes, G., West, Strahorn, O'Brien, Liston, Skindell, Seitz, Leland, Boyd, Upchurch, Sweeney, Clites, Brown.

To amend sections 133.06, 3302.036, 3302.042, 3302.12, 3302.16, 3302.17, 3302.18, 3310.03, 3311.29, and 3314.102; to enact new section 3302.10; and to repeal sections 3302.10, 3302.101, 3302.102, and 3302.11 of the Revised Code; and to repeal Sections 4, 5, and 6 of Am. Sub. H.B. 70 of the 131st General Assembly to dissolve academic distress commissions and to instead require the creation of community learning centers for buildings in low-performing school districts.
