INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 179 - Representative Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Miller, A., Riedel, Vitale, Hood.

To amend section 3717.22 of the Revised Code to exempt small wineries from retail food establishment licensure requirements under specific circumstances.

H. B. No. 180 - Representative Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Kent, Keller, Ginter, Riedel, Vitale, Smith, K., Strahorn.

To amend sections 2919.22 and 2945.63 of the Revised Code to prohibit a performance in which a child simulates sexual activity and, if the offender is a D liquor permit holder, to require the court to order the revocation of the permit.

Said bills were considered the first time.
