To amend sections 5107.05, 5107.10, and 5107.20 of the Revised Code regarding the pass-through of support payments under the Ohio Works First program.

To amend sections 3706.02, 3706.03, 4928.644, and 4928.66 and to enact sections 3706.40, 3706.42, 3706.44, 3706.45, 3706.46, 3706.47, 3706.471, 3706.48, 3706.481, 3706.482, 3706.49, 3706.50, 4928.46, 4928.47, and 4928.471 of the Revised Code to create the Ohio Clean Air Program, to facilitate and encourage electricity production and use from clean air resources, to facilitate investment to reduce the emissions from other generating technologies that can be readily dispatched to satisfy demand in real time, and proactively engage the buying power of consumers in this state for the purpose of improving air quality in this state.
