The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 206 - Representatives Stoltzfus, Boyd.

Cosponsors: Representatives Carfagna, Crawley, Crossman, Galonski, Kick, Manchester, Riedel, Stein.

To amend sections 5747.02, 5747.37, and 5747.98 of the Revised Code to enhance the tax credit awarded for family adoptions.

H. B. No. 207 - Representative Sheehy.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brown, Leland, Romanchuk, Kent, Perales, Riedel, Smith, K., Patterson, Crossman, Crawley, West, Strahorn, Weinstein, Miller, A., Miller, J.

To enact section 5534.812 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 475 in Lucas County as the "SGT Alex Drabik Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 208 - Representatives Roemer, Miller, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives O'Brien, Cera, McClain, Hoops.

To amend section 2903.13 of the Revised Code to increase the penalty for assault if the victim is acting as a sports official or the assault is committed in retaliation for the victim's actions as a sports official.

H. B. No. 209 - Representatives Carruthers, Kick.

Cosponsors: Representatives Carfagna, Miller, A., Miranda, Riedel, Rogers, Scherer, Seitz.

To amend sections 2103.02, 2103.09, and 2106.24 of the Revised Code to abolish the estate by dower.

H. B. No. 210 - Representative Carruthers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Weinstein.

To amend section 5101.27 and to enact sections 3301.531 and 5104.037 of the Revised Code regarding the screening of child care and preschool employees for tuberculosis and the disclosure of information about public assistance recipients to public health authorities.

H. B. No. 211 - Representative Arndt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Miller, J., Seitz, Schaffer.

To enact section 1547.305 of the Revised Code to establish a process by which a person may obtain title to a watercraft vessel or outboard motor that has been left on the person's property.

H. B. No. 212 - Representative Patton.

To enact section 1181.081 of the Revised Code to regulate nonbank automated teller machines.

H. B. No. 213 - Representative Arndt.

Cosponsor: Representative Romanchuk.

To amend sections 109.572, 149.43, 1347.08, 2925.01, 4743.02, 4751.01, 4751.041, 4751.043, 4751.044, 4751.05, 4751.06, 4751.07, 4751.08, 4751.10, 4751.11, 4751.12, 4751.14, 4751.99, 4776.01, 4776.20, and 5903.12; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicated in parentheses, sections 4751.03 (4751.02), 4751.041 (4751.151), 4751.042 (4751.021), 4751.043 (4751.381), 4751.044 (4751.26), 4751.05 (4751.15), 4751.06 (4751.20), 4751.07 (4751.24), 4751.08 (4751.201), 4751.10 (4751.32), 4751.11 (4751.33), 4751.12 (4751.35), 4751.13 (4751.36), and 4751.14 (4751.03); to enact new sections 4751.04 and 4751.10 and sections 4751.101, 4751.102, 4751.202, 4751.21, 4751.22, 4751.23, 4751.25, 4751.30, 4751.31, 4751.37, 4751.38, 4751.40, 4751.41, and 4751.45; to repeal sections 4751.02, 4751.04, and 4751.09 of the Revised Code; and to amend the version of section 109.572 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect on September 20, 2019, to revise the law governing the Board of Executives of Long-Term Services and Supports.
