The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Hillyer was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 214 - Representative Brown.

Cosponsors: Representatives Kent, West, Ingram, Smith, K., Weinstein, Smith, R., Miller, A., Lightbody, Kelly, Miranda, Boggs, Brent, Sobecki.

To enact section 4729.49 of the Revised Code regarding prescription drug readers for visually impaired patients.

H. B. No. 215 - Representatives Boggs, Carfagna.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brown, Cera, Crawley, Crossman, Edwards, Galonski, Hicks-Hudson, Kent, Leland, Lightbody, Liston, O'Brien, Romanchuk, Sheehy, Smith, K., Weinstein.

To amend sections 181.21, 181.26, 2967.14, 5120.021, 5120.038, 5120.113, and 5149.04 of the Revised Code to modify the Corrections Law regarding a Department of Rehabilitation and Correction reentry program for certain offenders, maximum workload and caseload standards for parole and field officers, GPS monitoring of offenders released from prison, and entry into LEADS of specified information about GPS-monitored offenders, and to require the Ohio Criminal Sentencing Commission to appoint an Offender Supervision Study Committee.

H. B. No. 216 - Representatives Skindell, Kelly.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boggs, Crossman, Crawley, Kent.

To amend sections 121.083 and 121.084 and to enact sections 4119.01, 4119.02, 4119.03, 4119.04, 4119.05, 4119.06, 4119.07, 4119.08, 4119.09, 4119.10, 4119.11, 4119.12, 4119.13, 4119.14, 4119.15, 4119.16, 4119.17, and 4119.18 of the Revised Code to regulate employment practices of formula retail and food services establishment employers and contractors and to require the purchaser of a formula retail or food services establishment to retain certain employees.

H. B. No. 217 - Representative Skindell.

Cosponsors: Representatives Miller, A., Smith, K., Boggs.

To amend sections 3101.08, 3101.10, 3101.11, and 3101.12 of the Revised Code to allow any person or entity that registers with the secretary of state to solemnize marriages.

H. B. No. 218 - Representative Patton.

To enact sections 168.01, 168.02, 168.03, 168.04, 168.05, 168.06, 168.07, 168.08, 168.09, 168.10, 168.11, 168.12, 168.13, 168.14, and 168.15 of the Revised Code to authorize certain public entities to enter into public-private initiatives with a private party through a public-private agreement regarding public facilities.

H. B. No. 219 - Representatives Becker, Hoops.

Cosponsors: Representatives DeVitis, Smith, T., Butler, Lang, Miller, J., Riedel, Seitz, Jones, Kent, Stein, Scherer, Roemer, Rogers, Arndt, O'Brien.

To amend sections 4301.03, 4301.22, 4301.24, 4301.32, 4301.322, 4301.33, 4301.332, 4301.333, 4301.334, 4301.353, 4301.355, 4301.356, 4301.362, 4301.365, 4301.366, 4301.37, 4301.39, 4301.403, 4301.404, 4301.99, 4303.184, 4303.19, 4303.202, 4303.203, 4303.204, 4303.205, 4303.30, and 4303.99, to enact new section 4303.182, and to repeal sections 4301.351, 4301.354, 4301.361, 4301.364, and 4303.182 of the Revised Code to alter the law relative to Sunday sales of beer and intoxicating liquor and to name the act the "Sunday Alcohol, Liquor, and Especially Spirits Act" or "SALES Act."

H. B. No. 220 - Representative Carfagna.

To enact section 9.16 of the Revised Code to allow a governmental entity to utilize distributed ledger technology, including blockchain technology.

Said bills were considered the first time.
