INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 255 - Representative Hoops.

To amend sections 107.03, 5703.48, and 5703.95 of the Revised Code to require the Tax Commissioner's biennial tax expenditure report to include information on property tax exemptions and to require the Tax Expenditure Review Committee to periodically review each property tax exemption.

H. B. No. 256 - Representative Hoops.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.956 of the Revised Code to create the "Liberty Center Local Schools" license plate.

H. B. No. 257 - Representative Green.

Cosponsors: Representatives Kent, Becker, Hoops, Riedel, Crossman, Perales, Ghanbari, Rogers.

To enact section 5534.823 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 125 in Brown County as the "PFC M. Preston Wheeler Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 258 - Representative Powell.

Cosponsors: Representatives Riedel, Becker, Koehler, Merrin, McClain, Wiggam.

To amend sections 4104.19, 4104.35, 4733.11, 4740.06, and 4765.30 and to enact section 4743.09 of the Revised Code to require a licensing authority to issue an occupational license to an applicant who completes a registered apprenticeship program and meets other requirements for licensure.

H. B. No. 259 - Representative Richardson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Romanchuk, Kent, Scherer, Perales, Patterson, McClain, Smith, K., Riedel, Weinstein, Crossman.

To enact section 5534.898 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 4 in Marion County as the "SGT David S. Harris Memorial Highway."

To amend sections 717.25, 1710.061, 3706.03, 4905.31, 4906.20, 4906.201, 4928.01, 4928.02, 4928.142, 4928.143, 4928.20, 4928.61, 4928.621, 4928.64, 4928.643, 4928.645, 4928.65, 4928.66, 4928.662, 4928.6612, and 5727.75; to enact sections 3706.40, 3706.42, 3706.44, 3706.46, 3706.47, 3706.48, 3706.481, 3706.482, 3706.483, 3706.484, 3706.485, 3706.486, 3706.50, 3706.51, 3706.52, and 4928.663 of the Revised Code to maintain operations of certified clean air resources, establish the Ohio generation and jobs incentive program and the energy performance and waste reduction program, and make changes regarding wind turbine siting.

To amend sections 2301.02 and 2301.03 of the Revised Code to specify that the domestic relations judge of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas to be elected in 2020 will take office on January 3, 2021.
