INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 318 - Representative Scherer.

To amend sections 3715.01, 3715.99, 3717.01, and 3719.99 and to enact sections 3715.026 and 3717.34 of the Revised Code regarding sales of kratom products.

H. B. No. 319 - Representatives West, Miller, A.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brown, Lepore-Hagan, Galonski, Boggs, Sheehy, Russo, Crossman, Kelly, Hicks-Hudson, Smith, K., Weinstein, Sobecki, Lightbody, Sykes, Robinson.

To repeal section 9.68 of the Revised Code and to repeal on December 28, 2019, the version of section 9.68 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect on that date, to restore local authority to generally regulate firearms-related conduct.

H. B. No. 320 - Representative West.

Cosponsors: Representatives Kelly, Galonski, Boggs, Smith, K., Sheehy, Weinstein, Skindell, Crawley, Crossman.

To amend section 2923.25 of the Revised Code to prohibit a federally licensed firearms dealer from transferring a firearm while a background check is pending unless 30 days have elapsed.

Said bills were considered the first time.
