INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 341 - Representative Ginter.

Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Blair, Lightbody, Koehler.

To amend sections 4723.52, 4729.45, 4729.553, 4730.56, and 4731.83 of the Revised Code regarding the administration of drugs for addiction treatment.

H. B. No. 342 - Representative Baldrige.

To enact section 5534.819 of the Revised Code to designate U.S. Route 52 in Adams County the "Adams County Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 343 - Representatives Patterson, Manning, G.

Cosponsors: Representatives Cera, Brent, Russo, Manning, D., Lightbody, Seitz, Smith, K., Strahorn, Blair, Crawley.

To make an appropriation related to emergency water and sewer system funding.

H. B. No. 344 - Representatives Howse, Patton.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brent, Romanchuk, Galonski, Smith, K., Riedel, Lepore-Hagan, Patterson, Lightbody.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.899 of the Revised Code to create the "Cleveland Clinic Children's" license plate.

H. B. No. 345 - Representative Jones.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ghanbari, Becker, Lang.

To amend section 4513.62 and to enact section 4505.104 of the Revised Code to allow the owner of a towing service or storage facility to obtain certificates of title to unclaimed motor vehicles ordered into storage by law enforcement.

H. B. No. 346 - Representative Patton.

To amend section 2927.02 of the Revised Code to prohibit the sale of

flavored electronic smoking devices and flavored vapor products and to establish a committee to study the health risks associated with such products.

H. B. No. 347 - Representative Patton.

To amend section 2927.02 of the Revised Code to place restrictions on retailers of vapor products.

H. B. No. 348 - Representative Miller, A.

To amend sections 2903.214, 2919.26, and 3113.31 and to enact section 2923.22 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person subject to a protection order from purchasing or receiving a firearm for the duration of the order.

To amend sections 2152.021, 2905.32, 2929.01, and 2950.01 of the Revised Code to require a juvenile court in specified circumstances to hold a delinquency complaint in abeyance in certain cases related to prostitution or human trafficking and to provide that the elements for the offense of trafficking in persons that apply to a victim under age 16 also apply to a victim who is age 16 or 17.
