**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 460** - Representatives Hambley, Skindell.

Cosponsors: Representatives Jones, Kick, O'Brien, Keller.

To amend sections 1901.07, 3501.01, 3505.03, 3505.04, 3513.07, 3513.257, 3513.31, and 3517.012 of the Revised Code to allow a partisan judicial candidate to appear on the general election ballot with a political party designation.

**H. B. No. 461** - Representative Brent.

Cosponsors: Representatives Robinson, Crawley, Keller, Smith, K., Crossman.

To amend section 3721.99 and to enact sections 3721.60, 3721.61, 3721.62, 3721.63, 3721.64, 3721.65, 3721.66, 3721.67, 3721.68, and 3721.69 of the Revised Code to permit a resident of a long-term care facility to conduct electronic monitoring of the resident's room, to designate this act as "Esther's Law," and to make an appropriation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
