INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 490 - Representatives Greenspan, Sheehy.

To amend section 4503.10 of the Revised Code to provide for the proration of the plug-in electric and hybrid motor vehicle registration fees.
