The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 524 - Representative Ghanbari.

To amend sections 2108.75, 2108.82, 3705.20, 4513.17, 4717.04, 4717.05, 4717.07, 4717.10, 4717.13, 4717.14, 4717.28, 4717.30, 4717.31, 4717.35, and 4717.36 of the Revised Code to make changes to the laws that impact funeral homes, funeral professionals, funeral hearses, funeral escort vehicles, and preneed funeral contracts.

H. B. No. 525 - Representative Jones.

To enact section 5534.872 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 60 in Washington County as the "U.S. Army Specialist Christian D. Ward Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 526 - Representatives Lang, Perales.

Cosponsors: Representatives Blair, Miranda, Weinstein, Smith, K., Riedel, Brent, Leland, Howse.

To enact section 5.246 of the Revised Code to designate September 15 to October 15 each year as "Hispanic and Latino Heritage Month."
