The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Scherer was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 528 - Representative LaRe.

Cosponsor: Representative Seitz.

To amend sections 3901.62 and 3901.64 of the Revised Code to amend the law related to insurers receiving credit for reinsurance.

H. B. No. 529 - Representatives Miller, J., Lepore-Hagan.

Cosponsor: Representative Smith, K.

To require one-time performance audits of school districts with a current academic distress commission.

H. B. No. 530 - Representative Grendell.

Cosponsors: Representatives Plummer, Stephens, Jones, Sweeney, Hambley, Roemer, Crossman, Manning, D., McClain, Rogers, Ginter.

To amend section 145.11 and to enact sections 145.096, 145.117, 145.118, 742.117, 3307.155, 3309.151, and 5505.066 of the Revised Code regarding state retirement system fiduciary duties, Public Employees Retirement System management fees and employee pay, and creating the Committee on Pension Salaries and Fees.

H. B. No. 531 - Representative Rogers.

To amend sections 117.01, 117.10, 187.01, and 187.04 and to enact section 117.561 of the Revised Code to establish that JobsOhio must submit to audits by the Auditor of State, and that an audit of JobsOhio must include an audit of the revenues, receipts, and expenditures of JobsOhio associated with the enterprise acquisition project.

H. B. No. 532 - Representatives Brinkman, Kelly.

To amend sections 3301.0718 and 3313.60 of the Revised Code and to amend Sections 265.10 and 265.80 of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly to require the State Board of Education to adopt standards for mental health education, to permit school districts to include mental health education in their curriculum, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 533 - Representative Sykes.

To amend section 121.30 and to enact sections 121.34, 121.341, and 121.342 of the Revised Code to create the Women's Policy and Research Commission and the Women's Policy and Research Center, to specify their powers and duties, and to make an appropriation.

To amend sections 4121.44, 4121.441, and 4121.442 of the Revised Code regarding identifying information in the medical management of workers' compensation claims.

H. B. No. 535 - Representatives Brent, Hicks-Hudson.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, 3328.24, and 4112.01 and to enact section 3319.48 of the Revised Code to enact the Creating a Respectful and Open World for Natural Hair (CROWN) Act to prohibit discrimination against an individual based on hair texture and protective hair styles.

H. B. No. 536 - Representatives Lepore-Hagan, Ghanbari.

To enact sections 4113.87, 4113.88, 4113.89, 4113.90, 4113.91, and 4113.92 of the Revised Code to enact the Consumer Protection Call Center Act regarding the eligibility of employers that relocate a call center to a foreign country to receive state grants, loans, and other benefits.

H. B. No. 537 - Representatives Sheehy, Sobecki.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.714 of the Revised Code to create the "Fallen Timbers Battlefield" license plate.

H. B. No. 538 - Representative Becker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brinkman, Kick, Cross, Riedel, Lang, Antani, Dean, Hood, Keller, Ginter, Vitale, Romanchuk, Grendell, Wiggam, Hillyer, Koehler, McClain, Manchester, Smith, T., Jordan, Powell, Reineke, Stoltzfus.

To enact sections 2904.01, 2904.02, 2904.03, 2904.031, 2904.032, 2904.04, 2904.05, 2904.22, 2904.30, 2904.35, and 2904.40 of the Revised Code to enact the Human Life Protection Act to prohibit abortions based upon a condition precedent.

Said bills were considered the first time.
