INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 604 - Representative Rogers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Blair, Howse, Lepore-Hagan, Miranda, O'Brien, Patterson, Seitz, West.

To amend sections 2151.358, 2923.125, 2923.128, 2923.1213, 2923.16, 2951.041, 2953.31, 2953.32, 2953.34, 2953.37, 2953.38, 2953.52, 2953.521, 2953.56, 2953.57, 2953.58, 2953.59, 4301.69, 4723.28, 4729.16, 4729.56, 4729.57, 4729.96, and 4752.09; to amend, for the purpose of adopting new section numbers as indicated in parentheses, sections 2953.37 (2953.35), 2953.38 (2953.36), 2953.52 (2953.33), and 2953.56 (2953.37); and to repeal sections 2953.321, 2953.33, 2953.35, 2953.36, 2953.51, 2953.53, 2953.54, 2953.55, and 2953.61 of the Revised Code regarding the Criminal Records Sealing Law.

H. B. No. 605 - Representatives Kelly, Patton.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boyd, Rogers, Galonski, Hambley, Leland, Brent, Russo, Ingram, Howse, Smith, K., Boggs, Brown, Sobecki, Lightbody, Denson, O'Brien, Weinstein.

To amend section 4123.68 of the Revised Code to make COVID-19 contracted by an employee of a retail food establishment or food processing establishment an occupational disease under the Workers' Compensation Law under certain circumstances and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 606 - Representative Grendell.

Cosponsor: Representative Seitz.

To grant civil immunity to a person who provides services for essential businesses and operations for injury, death, or loss that was caused by the transmission of COVID-19 during the period of emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 607 - Representatives Howse, Lepore-Hagan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Sobecki, Brent, Galonski, Kelly, Lightbody, Sheehy, Ingram, West, Miranda, Clites, Boggs, Upchurch, Russo, Miller, J.

To create the Gender Pay Disparity Task Force.

H. B. No. 608 - Representative Crossman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Weinstein, Patton, O'Brien, Lightbody, Sobecki, Lepore-Hagan, Sheehy, Miller, J., Ingram, Blair.

To make changes to the law regarding peace officer and firefighter certifications during the declaration of an emergency regarding COVID-19 and to declare an emergency.

Said bills were considered the first time.
