### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 619** - Representatives Jordan, Hillyer.

To enact section 3701.147 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Health to compile and publish certain information on its web site during a state of emergency relating to infectious disease.

**H. B. No. 620** - Representative Crawley.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brent, Boyd, Smith, K., Russo, Howse, Sheehy, Sobecki, Crossman, Leland, West, Blair.

To amend section 103.13 and to enact sections 103.132 and 3701.35 of the Revised Code to require the Legislative Service Commission to create health impact statements for introduced bills and to create the Health and Equity Interagency Team.

**H. B. No. 621** - Representatives Cross, Wilkin.

To amend sections 3701.352, 3707.48, and 3709.211 and to enact sections 3701.353, 3707.481, and 3709.212 of the Revised Code to enact The Business Fairness Act and to declare an emergency.

Said bills were considered the first time.
