### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 622** - Representative Ingram.

To suspend child support obligations for obligors who have lost income during the period of the state of emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 623** - Representative Cross.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to authorize a two-year income tax deduction for out-of-pocket dental expenses.

**H. B. No. 624** - Representative Grendell.

Cosponsors: Representatives Wiggam, Romanchuk, Riedel, Roemer, Stein, Keller, Cross.

To require the reporting and release of certain COVID-19 testing and related information and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 625** - Representative Galonski.

To amend section 5.02 of the Revised Code to designate the hardy mum as one of the state's flowers.

**H. B. No. 626** - Representatives Sobecki, Miller, J.

To amend sections 3314.09 and 3327.01 and to enact section 3301.165 of the Revised Code to specify that a school district is not required to plan its transportation schedule based on the start and end times of those nonpublic schools to which it transports students, to require community schools and chartered nonpublic schools to provide certain information related to student transportation to school districts annually, and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 627** - Representatives Sobecki, Crawley.

To exempt school districts and educational service centers from

prohibitions against reductions in student transportation for the 2020-2021 school year and to declare an emergency.
