H. B. No. 705 - Representative Miller, A.

To amend sections 3767.41, 3767.50, 3767.99, 5721.17, 5721.18, 5721.19, 5721.192, 5723.05, and 5723.18 of the Revised Code to amend the law regarding public nuisances and blight foreclosure actions and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 706 - Representatives Crawley, West.

To enact section 109.749 of the Revised Code to require peace officers to complete training on de-escalation techniques, implicit bias, procedural justice, and mental health issues, to require information regarding mental health resources and available support be provided to peace officers annually, and to make an appropriation.
