To amend section 5747.98 and to enact sections 122.851 and 5747.67 of the Revised Code to authorize a refundable income tax credit for investing in a sound recording production company.

H. B. No. 726 - Representative Wiggam.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lang, Keller, Becker, Riedel, Zeltwanger, Holmes, A., Smith, T., Romanchuk, Kick, Fraizer, Cross, Vitale, Grendell, Hillyer.

To enact section 3707.512 of the Revised Code to establish requirements for organizing youth athletic activities during outbreaks of contagious disease or illness and to declare an emergency.
