INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 749 - Representative Roemer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Reineke, Lang.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to temporarily suspend provisions relating to bonus depreciation adjustments for a taxpayer with a federal net operating loss.

H. B. No. 750 - Representatives Crossman, Blair.

Cosponsors: Representatives Leland, Galonski, Brown, Patterson, Miller, J., Sobecki, Russo, Lepore-Hagan, Weinstein, O'Brien, Lightbody, Liston.

To enact section 2961.04 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person who is currently charged with a public corruption offense from taking office as a member of the General Assembly, to require a current member who is charged with a public corruption offense to repay certain amounts to the state, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 751 - Representative Hillyer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Lang.

To amend section 5715.19 of the Revised Code to modify the law regarding property tax valuation complaints.

Said bills were considered the first time.
