### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 784** - Representatives Abrams, Carruthers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Kick, Wiggam, Becker, Lang, Riedel, Perales, Seitz, Carfagna, Cross.

To amend sections 2307.601, 2901.09, 2909.05, 2917.02, 2917.03, 2917.11, 2923.31, and 2929.14 and to enact sections 2307.701, 2903.131, 2917.06, and 2927.121 of the Revised Code to increase penalties for certain assault, vandalism, and riot offenses, to allow peace officers to bring civil suits against persons participating in a riot, and to prohibit bias motivated intimidation of first responders.

**H. B. No. 785** - Representatives Smith, K., Callender.

Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Carruthers, Cera, Weinstein, Kelly, Crossman, Boyd, Upchurch, Miller, A.

To authorize grants for operators of performing arts venues, producers of performing arts, and promoters of performing artists, to make an appropriation, and to declare an emergency.

Said bills were considered the first time.
