INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 91 - Senator Maharath

To amend sections 4117.10 and 5747.01 and to enact sections 4143.01, 4143.02, 4143.03, 4143.04, 4143.05, 4143.06, 4143.07, 4143.08, 4143.09, 4143.10, 4143.11, 4143.12, 4143.13, 4143.14, and 4143.99 of the Revised Code to establish family and medical leave insurance benefits.

S. B. No. 92 - Senator Maharath

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, 4111.04, 4111.05, 4111.06, 4111.07, 4111.09, 4111.11, 4111.12, 4111.13, 4111.17, 4111.99, and 4112.01; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 4111.17 (4112.17) of the Revised Code to enact the "Fair and Acceptable Income Required (FAIR) Act" and to revise the enforcement of the prohibitions against discrimination in the payment of wages.

S. B. No. 93 - Senator Maharath

To amend sections 4111.02, 4111.08, 4111.10, 4111.13, 4111.14, 4111.99, 4112.01, and 4112.05 and to enact sections 4111.021, 4111.031, and 4112.025 of the Revised Code regarding wages, overtime, and other matters related to the employment of domestic workers.

S. B. No. 94 - Senator Maharath

To amend sections 4112.01, 4112.05, 4112.07, and 4113.71 and to enact section 4112.025 of the Revised Code to enact the "Ohio Pregnant Workers Fairness Act" to generally require employers to make reasonable accommodations for employees who are pregnant or breastfeeding.

S. B. No. 95 - Senators Peterson, Kunze

Cosponsors: Senators Wilson, Rulli, Hackett, Huffman, S., Lehner

To amend sections 122.17, 3735.65, 3735.67, 3735.671, 5709.61, 5709.62, 5709.63, 5709.631, 5709.632, and 5751.01 of the Revised Code to enhance state and local tax inducements for businesses making substantial fixed asset and employment investments and their suppliers.
