INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 115 - Senator Maharath

To amend section 4301.69 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person under 21 years old from entering or being allowed to enter a bar.

S. B. No. 116 - Senator Maharath

To enact section 3902.50 of the Revised Code to require that health benefit plans provide coverage for maternity services.

S. B. No. 117 - Senator Maharath

To amend section 2907.29 and to enact sections 3727.61, 3727.611, and 3727.612 of the Revised Code to require hospitals to provide specified services to victims of sexual assault.
