INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 173 - Senator Kunze.

To enact section 5.2521 of the Revised Code to designate September as "Hirschsprung's Disease Awareness Month."

S. B. No. 174 - Senator Kunze.

Cosponsors: Senators Maharath, Williams.

To enact section 5.246 of the Revised Code to designate September 7 as "Ohio Grateful Patient Day."

S. B. No. 175 - Senator Schaffer.

Cosponsor: Senator Eklund.

To amend section 2923.126 of the Revised Code to grant civil immunity to nonprofit corporations and persons associated with them for certain injuries, deaths, or losses resulting from the carrying of handguns.

S. B. No. 176 - Senator Schaffer.

To amend sections 715.27, 3781.102, 4740.01, 4740.03, 4740.04, 4740.05, 4740.06, 4740.07, 4740.11, 4740.12, 4740.13, 4740.131, 4740.14, 4740.16, and 4764.03 of the Revised Code to license residential only construction contractors and to make changes to the law regulating specialty construction contractors.
