S. B. No. 199 - Senator Huffman, M.

To formally state the General Assembly's intention to create a process for certifying eligible scholarship-granting organizations.

S. B. No. 200 - Senators Lehner, Brenner.

Cosponsor: Senator Thomas.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3323.11, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact sections 3319.077 and 3319.078 of the Revised Code with regard to professional development for screening and intervention for children with dyslexia.
