TION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 248 - Senator Schaffer.

Co-sponsor: Senator Brenner.

To amend section 3781.1010 of the Revised Code to extend until November 30, 2022, the moratorium on the building code requirement for storm shelters for school construction projects.

S. B. No. 249 - Senator Lehner.

Co-sponsors: Senators Williams, Antonio, Craig, Yuko, Fedor.

To amend sections 3781.109 and 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.79 of the Revised Code to enact Matthew's Law, requiring public buildings to have at least one rest room facility with an adult changing station and authorizing an income tax credit for installation.
