**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

**S. B. No. 305** - Senator Craig.

Cosponsors: Senators Thomas, Antonio, Maharath.

To amend section 3902.30 of the Revised Code to require health plan issuers to cover telemedicine services during a state of emergency and to declare an emergency.

**S. B. No. 306** - Senator Maharath.

Cosponsor: Senator Antonio.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to allow individuals who rent their primary residence to claim an income tax deduction of up to \$3,000 per year.

**S. B. No. 307** - Senator Gavarone.

To authorize a temporary sales and use tax exemption for personal protective equipment and to declare an emergency.
