INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 308 - Senator Huffman, M.

Cosponsors: Senators Huffman, S., Roegner, Hottinger, Hackett, Schuring.

To amend section 2305.2311 and to enact section 2305.2312 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing immunity from civil liability and professional discipline for health care providers during disasters or emergencies, to provide qualified civil immunity to service providers providing services during and after a government-declared disaster, and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 309 - Senator Gavarone.

To amend section 3749.01 of the Revised Code to allow certified swimming classes to take place at a private residential swimming pool without requiring the pool's operator to obtain a public swimming pool license and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 310 - Senator Dolan.

To provide for the distribution of some federal coronavirus relief funding to local subdivisions, to make an appropriation, and to declare an emergency.
