INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 335 - Senator Craig.

Cosponsors: Senators Thomas, Antonio, Yuko, Maharath, Fedor.

To amend sections 323.152, 323.153, and 4503.06 of the Revised Code to reduce property taxes on owner-occupied homes to the extent that property taxes increase by more than 3% from the previous year and to name this act the Property Tax Relief and Local Government Support Act.

S. B. No. 336 - Senator Hoagland.

To amend sections 1509.02 and 1509.22 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing the permitting of oil and gas brine injection wells.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Gavarone offered the following concurrent resolution:

S. C. R. No. 16-Senator Gavarone.

To call for justice for victims of excessive force by police and declare opposition to efforts to defund law enforcement.

The question being, "Shall the concurrent resolution, **S. C. R. No. 16**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Gavarone, **S. C. R. No. 16**, was referred to the Committee on Rules and Reference.
