INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 360 - Senator Obhof.

Cosponsors: Senators Peterson, Hottinger, Brenner, Johnson, Roegner, Rulli, Schaffer.

To enact section 9.71 of the Revised Code to generally bar public officials from prohibiting all federally licensed firearms dealers in the state or a specified geographic area from the commercial sale or transfer of firearms or their components or ammunition.

S. B. No. 361 - Senator Burke.

To amend sections 135.63, 135.78, 1733.04, and 1733.24 and to enact sections 135.79, 135.791, 135.792, 135.793, 135.794, 135.795, and 135.796 of the Revised Code to create the adoption linked deposit program.
