# BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The border of the United States presents unique

challenges and threats to the national security of the country;	4

WHEREAS, Transnational criminal organizations, commonly	6
known as drug cartels, control the majority of the flow of	7
opioids, heroin, methamphetamine, and cocaine and these groups	8
maintain territorial influence over large regions used for the	9
cultivation, production, importation, and transportation of	10
these illicit drugs into the United States and Ohio; and	11

WHEREAS, The drug cartels are also responsible for the	12
proliferation of human trafficking in the United States,	13
particularly in Ohio, as part and parcel of their drug	14
trafficking operations; and	15
WHEREAS, The drug cartels currently conduct operations on	16
United States soil in furtherance of drug trafficking and human	17
trafficking; and	18
WHEREAS, Abuse of opioids, including fentanyl, and human	19
trafficking are identified as direct threats to the economy,	20
well-being, and overall vitality of the state of Ohio, its	21
citizens, and future generations; and	22
WHEREAS, Section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act	23
(8 U.S.C. 1189) authorizes the United States Secretary of State,	24
in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury and the	25
Attorney General, to designate an organization as a foreign	26
terrorist organization when certain criteria are met; and	27
WHEREAS, The drug cartels meet the criteria to be	28
designated foreign terrorist organizations under Section 219,	29
given that they are foreign in nature, they engage in or retain	30
the capability and intent to engage in terrorism, and they	31
threaten the security of United States nationals and the	32
national defense, foreign relations, and economic interests of	33
the United States; now therefore be it	34
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 133rd General	35
Assembly of the State of Ohio, respectfully urge the federal	36
government to designate drug cartels as foreign terrorist	37
organizations, so that the government may use appropriate means	38
to mitigate and eventually eliminate the operations of the	39
cartels; and be it further	40
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	41
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the	42
