A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge Congress to ensure organizations that have been 1
awarded federal grants receive funding retroactively 2
to account for funding not received during a partial 3
federal government shutdown. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, The United States federal government partially shut 5
down on December 22, 2018; and 6

WHEREAS, The partial government shutdown affects many 7
government functions that provide important and necessary 8
resources to the country; and 9

WHEREAS, Many federal employees and organizations do not 10
receive pay or funding during a partial government shutdown; and 11

WHEREAS, There are several important organizations that have 12
been awarded federal grants that do not receive the grant funds 13
during a partial government shutdown; now therefore be it 14

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 133rd General Assembly 15
of the State of Ohio, urge the Congress of the United States to 16
pass legislation to ensure that those organizations awarded 17
federal grants retroactively receive the funding that is not 18
received during a partial government shutdown; and be it further 19

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives 20
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the 21
President of the United States, the President Pro Tempore and 22
Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and Clerk of 23
the United States House of Representatives, each member of the 24
Ohio Congressional delegation, and the news media of Ohio. 25
